



### Participant Rules and Standards / Dress Code for Participants

1. Hair should be neat, clean, and worn in good taste.
2. Facial hair should be well groomed at all times. Participants are not allowed to have beards or goatees. You will shave every day if needed.
3. Boys, no earrings can be worn at any time. Girls, no earrings are to be worn during practices or during the match.
4. No clothing that represents alcohol, tobacco, obscene words/pictures or drugs will be worn at any time.
5. Hats/caps that are not offensive may be worn, but not inside.
6. Pants must be worn above the hips. No tank tops will be worn to meals.
7. No rags or bandanas may be worn.
8. Boys need to bring slacks, socks, and dress shoes to wear at the banquet on Friday night. Girls will need to bring a dress or skirt and blouse for the banquet.
9. Clothes which are acceptable: shorts, tennis shoes, slacks, dresses, skirts, t-shirts that are in good taste, knit or sport shirts, slides. Boys are to wear shirts whenever they are outside their rooms.
10. Girls, sports bras are not considered outer clothing.

### CODE OF CONDUCT

The following may or will result in the removal of a Soccer Classic participant:

1. Possessing, selling, or consuming drugs and/or alcoholic beverages.
2. Hitting/striking a teammate or coach. Fighting.
3. Possessing any kind of illegal weapon.
4. Being arrested for criminal charges.
5. Missing curfew, practice, team meetings, or any other function associated with the North-South Soccer Classic without permission of the coaching staff.
6. Failing to turn in motor vehicle keys to the North-South Soccer Classic staff. Bringing a motor vehicle is not recommended; if this is the only means of transportation the keys must be given to the designated staff member upon arrival.
